THE CROCHET FLOWER

NECESSARY

- 50 gr of Navy cotton by Adriafil
- 25 gr of Navy cotton by Adriafil if you want to crochet the flower in TWO-COLORS
- crochet hook n° 5 (H)
- 1 safety pin
- a tapestry needle

SKILLS

Single and Double Crochet: See the attached schemes



HOW TO

“ONE-COLOR” FLOWER:

With your favorite color Navy cotton and an H crochet hook, chain 53

1° round: 1 double c. in the 5th chain from hook (it's the first V stitch) , *ch. 1., skip 1 ch, (1 dc, 1 ch., 1 dc.) in the next ch, (V stitch); repeat from * until you'll have 25 V stitches on the foundation row.

2° round: ch. 3 (counts as 1 Double Crochet), turn, 5 dc in next chain (the one between 2 dc into a V st. in the previous round) [first shell] , * 1 sc in next ch, (the one between 2 V sts in the previous round) 6 dc in next ch. (the one between 2 dc into a V st. in the previous round)[shell]; repeat from * on, until you'll have 25 shells at the end of the round.

“TWO-COLOR” FLOWER:

With your favorite color Navy cotton and an H crochet hook, chain 53

1° and 2° Round: work the same as for ONE-COLOR FLOWER.

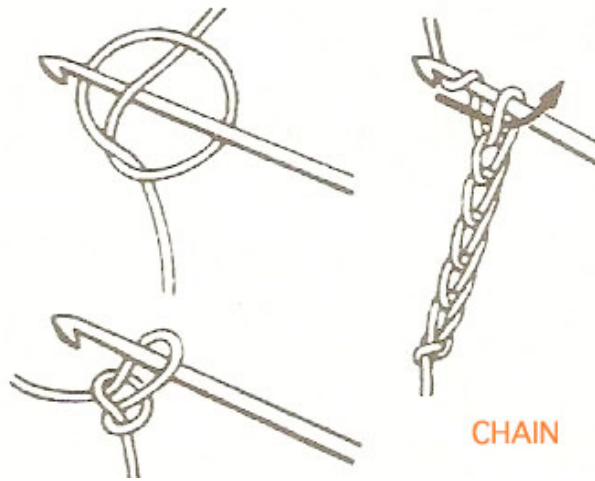
3° Round: Change into the second yarn color you choose.

Ch. 1, turn, 1 sc in every sc. , remembering to work 2 sc in each of the 3 central dc of every shell.

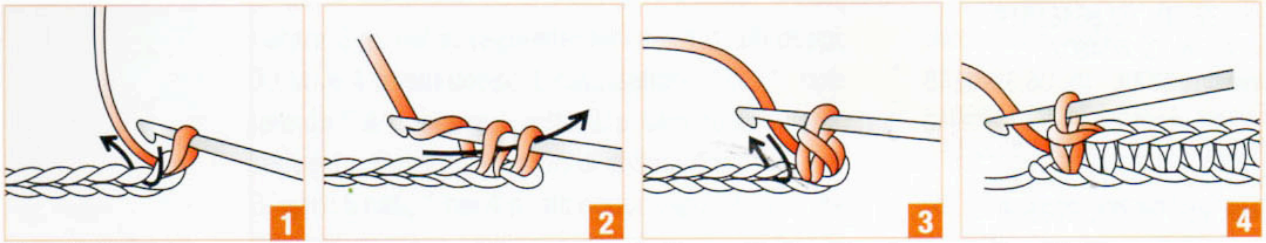
FINISHING

Thread the yarn into a tapestry needle. Roll the first shell firmly, forming the center of the rose. Sew it with 2-3 points. Turn the remaining previously worked string to form a FLOWER and stop it by stitching it in and out through the holes in the foundation chain to the ends of the flower. If you want to make a brooch, fasten the safety pin on the back of the flower with stitches.
