- **Rounds:** 8
- **Diameter:** 10 cm (approx. 3,9")
- **Materials:** cotton thread size 10; 1,5 mm hook.
You may use any yarn and hook you like.
- **Yarn needed:** 25 yards (≈4 g)

Notes

- Please read the «STITCH GUIDE» section before beginning ;
- Some special stitches are in the text of the pattern, not in the «STITCH GUIDE»;
- Join the rounds with a SLST in the top of the beginning stitch;
- The amount of stitches for each round is listed at the end of the round;
- Pattern repeats are marked with * and **bold**;
- Recommendations and notes are *italics*;
- Groups of stitches are listed in [] ;
- If you have any questions or you found some errors or typographical mistakes, please contact me and let me know.

Stitch guide

ST - stitch.

ch - chain.

SLST - slip stitch.

SC - single crochet.

DC - double crochet.

TR - treble (2 yo).

FP-... - Complete stitch around the **front** post of stitch indicated.

BP-... - Complete stitch around the **back** post of stitch indicated.

CLUSTER - A set of stitches joined together at the top. Holding back the last loop of all stitches in cluster set, complete the number of stitches into the stitch or space indicated, yarn over, and pull through all loops on hook.

SPLIT - (decrease) two indicated stitches together. Holding back the last loop of both stitches, make first stitch into the stitch or space indicated (2 loops on hook), make second stitch into the stitch or space indicated (3 loops on hook). Yarn over, pull through all three loops on hook .

0 round	5 CH join with SLST in first CH to form a circle	
1 round	6 CH (counts as TR + 2 CH), [TR, 2 CH] 9 times, SLST into the 4th CH <i>Instead 6 CH you may work the Beginning TR and 2 CH.</i>	10 TR, 10 2-CH spaces
2 round	FP-SLST around the first TR, 2 CH, FP-DC around the same TR, 1 CH, DC into the next space, 1 CH, *CLUSTER 2FP-DC around the next TR, 1 CH, DC into the next space, 1 CH* around, join	10 CLUSTER, 10 DC, 20 1-CH spaces
3 round	1 CH, FP-SC around the first CLUSTER, 3 CH, BP-SC around the next DC, 3 CH, *FP-SC around the next CLUSTER, 3 CH, BP-SC around the next DC, 3 CH* around, join <i>Mark the 2nd FP-SC</i>	10 FP-SC, 10 BP-SC, 20 3-CH spaces
4 round	SLST into the next space, 1 CH, SC into the same space, 3 CH, *SC into the next space, 3 CH* around, join	20 SC, 20 3-CH spaces
5 round	SLST into the next space, 1 CH, SC into the same space, FP-TR around the marked FP-SC, 5 DC into the next space, FP-TR around the same FP-SC, *SC into the next space, FP-TR around the next FP-SC, 5DC into the next space, FP-TR around the same FP-SC* around, join	20 FP-TR, 50 DC, 10 SC
6 round	1 CH, *SPLIT 2FP-DC (using the previous FP-TR (in round 5) as the first stitch, and the next FP-TR (in round 5) as the second stitch), [BP-DC around the next DC, 1 CH] 4 times, BP-DC around the next DC* around, join	10 SPLIT, 50 BP-DC, 40 1-CH spaces
7 round	1 CH, FP-SC around the SPLIT, 3 CH, [SC into the next space, 3 CH] 4 times, *FP-SC around the next SPLIT, 3 CH, [SC into the next space, 3 CH] 4 times* around, join	10 FP-SC, 40 SC, 50 3-CH spaces
8 round	SLST into the next space, 1 CH, SC into the same space, 2 SC into the next space, [2 SC, Picot-3CH, 2 SC] into the next space, 2 SC into the next space, 1 SC into the next space, *SC into the next space, 2 SC into the next space, [2 SC, Picot-3CH, 2 SC] into the next space, 2 SC into the next space, 1 SC into the next* around, join	50 SC, 10 Picot-3CH
	Picot-3CH: 3 CH, SLST into the 1st CH.	

Cut thread, fasten off, weave in all ends.

Block the doily.
